COUNTING THE DAYS UNTIL COVID RESTRICTIONS ARE LIFTED

During this year long lockdown, the Community Centre has been in the safe hands of the management committee and those 'hands' are eager to welcome everyone back as soon as possible.

The key dates for your diaries (as taken from the government's website) are:

MAY 17th Step 3

From 17 May at the earliest, organised adult indoor group sports and exercise classes which includes participatory dance activities will be able to resume. Indoor events will be able to have 50% of the venue's capacity. Social distancing will still apply.

JUNE 21st Step 4

Step 4 will take place no earlier than 21 June and will remove all legal limits on social contact with events taking place at capacity restrictions above those in Step 3.

Further information about the re-opening requirements and safety protocols or any changes to the 'Roadmap' arrangements will be available shortly.
